**CAMP FACILITIES**

Eagle River Methodist Camp is located at 28 mile on the Glacier Highway. The camp lodge is large and bright, and has a clean and wonderful dance floor!

Dances and most workshops will be held in the camp lodge. Rustic cabins have bunks with mattresses. A grassy meadow provides space for tent campers. There is a bathhouse with full facilities and hot water.

Clean “dancing-only” shoes are essential, to keep our dance floor clean. Boots make it easier to get around outside in wet weather.

We ask campers to respect the camp policy of no pets or alcohol. There is no smoking in the camp buildings.

Car-pooling is recommended, as there is limited space in the parking lot.

**CHILDREN**

Families with children are very welcome. Parents must supervise their children. There will be no special activities planned for kids. All campers under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or designated adult who is completely responsible for their safety, supervision and wellbeing.

Juneau contra dancers extend a special invitation to dancers and musicians who live outside of Juneau. We will arrange rides to the camp, transportation to and from the airport or ferry, and housing in Juneau one day before and after the camp. with Dance Caller **Susan Michaels**

The Camp DAMP 2017 dance band is Seattle's **KGB**: **Julie King** on piano, **Claude Ginsburg** on fiddle, and **Dave Bartley** on guitar, mandolin and cittern! Long time campers may remember them as our great guest band in 1997. **KGB** has a knack of taking dancers to the edge but coming back just in time to keep everything under control, pulling your feet joyfully across the floor. **KGB** creates 'subversive music', lulling the unwary with traditional New England dance tunes, then jumping off into Balkan modalities, tango riffs, and bluesy jigs. **Julie's** keyboard spans the emotional range from majestic to down and dirty. **Claude's** violin deftly inserts elements of Klezmer, Latin American, jazz fusion and French Romantic music into New England fiddle tunes. **Dave** creates percussive energy and dazzling riffs on anything with strings.

**Susan Michaels**, our dance caller for 2017, has been calling contras and squares from coast to coast for more than 30 years, building community, facilitating joy, and just plain having fun. Her dances are often inventive, with drive and flow, but hold onto the roots of social dance. Susan's special blend of dry, quirky humor and great storytelling are perfect for our relaxed, easy camp atmosphere.

The **August 4–6 Camp DAMP 2017 weekend** begins with Friday registration at 3:00 p.m., followed by dinner at 7:00 p.m. and a welcome dance. Saturday and Sunday feature dances, dance and music workshops, singing, and great food. There will be dances featuring favorite bands and callers from Southeast Alaska on late Friday and Saturday nights and Sunday morning, plus daily jam sessions.

In the Camp DAMP tradition, campers prepare the tasty meals and each person contributes by doing about two hours of chores. 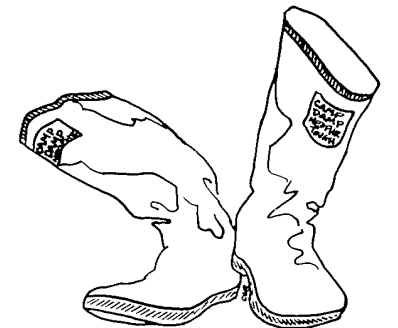
