CAMP FACILITIES

Eagle River Methodist Camp is located at 28 mile on the Glacier Highway. The camp lodge is large and bright, and has a clean and wonderful dance floor!

Dances and most workshops will be held in the camp lodge. Rustic cabins have bunks with mattresses. A grassy meadow provides space for tent campers. There is a bathhouse with full facilities and hot water.

Clean “dancing-only” shoes are essential, to keep our dance floor clean. Boots make it easier to get around outside.

We ask campers to respect the camp policy of no pets or alcohol. There is no smoking in the camp buildings.

Car-pooling is recommended, as there is limited space in the parking lot.

Because of our limited dance space (75 adults), please do not bring unregistered guests to camp.

CHILDREN

Families with children are very welcome. Parents must supervise their children. There are no special activities planned for children (unless they are offered as a Camper-Led Activity). All campers under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or designated adult who is completely responsible for their safety, supervision and wellbeing.

CHORES

All campers are asked to contribute to our fun and successful weekend by assisting with about two hours of chores.

The Juneau Dance Camp 2018 dance band is ***Cascade Crossing*** – one of the most sought-after bands in the Pacific Northwest. Formed in 2006, Cascade Crossing features Lori Prime (fiddle), Sarah Goss (whistle, oboe), Rich Goss (guitar, percussion) and Carl Thor (piano). This lively band has played for contra dances up and down the west coast from Vancouver BC to San Diego. Along the way they have developed a reputation for intense creativity and a habit of energizing dance crowds. You can expect the unexpected from this band – fueled by their variety of instrumentation, penchant for exploring many different musical styles, and utter enjoyment playing together. Cascade Crossing lights up the dance hall with an exciting palette of musical colors and textures, from hard-driving reels to smooth, mysterious jigs and romantic waltzes.

Frannie Marr, our dance caller for 2018, hails from San Diego. Frannie draws on her experience as a traveling dancer and elementary school teacher to efficiently teach and call dances that people love. Her hallmarks are quick walk-throughs, clear calling, and letting the dance and music flow. Frannie and Cascade Crossing enjoy working together to make dance camp weekends varied, fun and memorable!
